Silky with a juicy acid, this dazzler starts with aromas of blackberry, boysenberry, cassis and sweet anise all at once, followed by toasted oak at the tail end. To the taste, the oak and licorice flavors are still there, but complemented with mixed berries and a long finish. www.farniente.com.
